

Aviation Calendar Instructions

For Members Use

In order to access the D1SR Aviation Mission Calendar, you must be granted access through the Aviation Board. Please contact Darryl Laxton @ "DARRYLUSCGAUX@aol.com" with your First and Last name, member id number, flotilla, weight and email address to get access. He will then send instructions on how to create a password for viewing.

Currently, all members with an Aviation Certification (Air Observer, Aircrew, Copilot, First Pilot, Aircraft Commander) in AUXDATA have an un-activated access account to the calendar. You need to follow the instructions here to activate your account.

First, you will point your browser to the new District 1 Southern website at <http://www.d1south.org>. This site is very much under construction, and there may be changes from day to day. Once there, click on the

tab. Then click on the "Aviation Calendar" link. You will be presented with a login box that looks like this:

In the top line, enter your Auxiliary Member number. If this is your first time here, enter the default password of asdf1234 and hit the Login button. Next, you will see this:

While I'm sure you're all used to this, type in a new password in both boxes and click the submit button. If you already have an activated password for the Auxiliary eDirectory, please use that same password here. And if you don't have an activated password for the Auxiliary eDirectory, go there now and get yourself registered.

Once you have successfully changed your password, you will not need to do the last step, unless we need you to. You will just login with your member number and the new password you created.

In the calendar

Now, you are in the calendar. The very top section will be notes and important links for you. The middle section is a grid of the current month. Each day with assigned missions will have the route abbreviation and the PIC listed next to it.
